Ben-Gurion University

Ben-Gurion University of the Negev, located in Beer Sheva in the northern Negev and in Eilat in the Arava, was created in 1969 to transform the Negev. Named after David Ben-Gurion, Israel's first prime minister, BGU is Israel's fastest-growing institution of higher education, with an international reputation for innovative research, a modern 21st century campus and a dynamic, diverse student body. The University actively promotes high-tech industry, agriculture, health services and education in the region while building bridges of peace between Israel and its Arab neighbors through initiatives in science, research and development.

Programs

The University's **Ginsburg-Ingerman Overseas Student Program** offers a small, fully integrated immersion Study Abroad experience. Students live in dorms with Israeli students or in Pioneering student villages in association with the Ayalim Project (www.ayalim.org.il), are members of the BGU student association, participate in all campus events and have the opportunity to participate in internships for academic credit, as well as volunteering in the community.

Hebrew University

Hebrew University's classrooms offer unique learning experiences and panoramic views of the 3,000-year-old city of Jerusalem. This is Israel's first and leading university, and a symbol of the cultural rebirth of the Jewish nation in its ancestral homeland.
